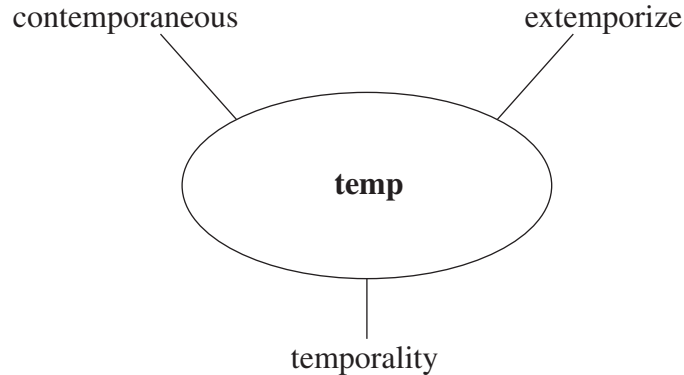


Vocabulary Strategy

THE LATIN ROOT *temp*

Our root *temp-* comes from the Latin word *tempus*, meaning “time” or “a fixed period.” This root is found in several English words.
