## FIRST-PERSON POINT OF VIEW

In a story told from the **first-person point of view**, the narrator is a character in the story and participates in the story’s action. In “Araby,” the narrator is the main character, a young boy. He speaks directly to readers, using the pronoun *I*. Readers see everything through the narrator’s eyes, and his thoughts and comments convey the intensity of his feelings.
