Directions: Give your peer reader this sheet and have him or her record answers to the following questions and then give you suggestions for revision.

1. Does the introduction engage the reader, provide background information, and clearly state the thesis

2. Does the body include only relevant main ideas and supporting evidence? Is each main idea supported

3. Are facts and ideas stated mainly in your own words

4. Are sources credited appropriately? Are citations correctly placed and punctuated?

5. Does the conclusion restate the thesis and provide additional insight into the subject?

6. Is the Works Cited list complete and correctly formatted?
